### Used Household Goods and Personal Effects

# **Documents Required**

- Passport
- Original bill of lading (OBL) / air waybill (AWB)
- Detailed inventory
- Certificate of residence

# **Specific Information**

Owners of the goods having lived abroad for at least 6 months prior to import may qualify for a duty exemption.

## **Motor Vehicles**

**Documents Required** 

Title / registration

Proof of insurance (must state the beginning and ending dates of the policy)

OBL / AWB

## **Specific Information**

- Owners of the goods must have lived abroad for at least 12 months to import a motor vehicle duty free.
- The motorized vehicle (autos and motorcycles) must have been in the possession and used for at least 12 months prior to import.

#### Pets

### **Documents Required**

- Vaccination record
- Veterinary health certificate
- Pet passport in Dutch or English

## **Specific Information**

- Documents must accompany pets during travel.
- Pets must comply with all health regulations and have been vaccinated at least 30 days but less than 12 months prior to import.

# **Consignment Instructions**

Recommended: Contact the destination agent to ensure all requirements have been met prior to import, especially for differences regarding air / sea shipments.
