Used Household Goods and Personal Effects

Documents Required Copy of passport Packing list Original bill of lading (OBL) - no express release accepted / air waybill (AWB) Original inventory in French dated, valued, and signed by the owner of the goods Certificate of change of residence / certificate of transfer Proof of residence in French Guyana (electricity bill, signed lease, etc.) less than 3 months old Non-sale certificate Cer<u>t</u>ificate of property

Specific Information

Without a certificate of change of residence or certificate of transfer, the owner of the goods will have to pay the 'Octroi de Mer' (between 12% and 22% of the CAF value).

Motor Vehicles

Documents Required

- Original registration card
- Certificate of insurance
- Non-sale certificate

Specific Information

Without a certificate of change of residence or certificate of transfer, the owner of the goods will have to pay the 'Octroi de Mer' (between 12% and 22% of the CAF value).

Pets

Documents Required

- Import permit
- Rabies vaccination record

Specific Information

- The importation of animals requires authorization prior to the arrival of the animal.
- Quarantine is not required for animals. Livestock
- require an import permit.
- Animals imported with rabies must be placed in quarantine prior to entry into Guyana.

Restricted/Dutiable Items

• The following household goods may be imported duty free within the limits indicated:

- ° Cigarettes (200)
 - ^o Cigars (50)
 - ^o Tobacco (225g)
 - ^o Perfume (250ml)
 - ^o Wine (750 ml)
 - ° Spirits (750 ml)
 - ^o Perfume for private use (reasonable quantity; contact agent) Firearms
 - and ammunitions (authorization from the territorial administration is required and difficult to obtain)
 - ^o Weapons, explosives and ammunition (authorization from the territorial administration required)
 - ^o Plant materials (import permit required)
 - Fresh and raw meat (import permit and an inspection by qualified official required) Fresh fruit
 - ^o Organic and inorganic fertilizers
 - ° Makeup

Prohibited Items

- Knives and dangerous weapons
- Counterfeit goods
- Pornographic materials

Consignment Instructions

Recommended: Contact the destination agent to ensure all requirements have been met prior to import, especially for differences regarding air / sea shipments.
